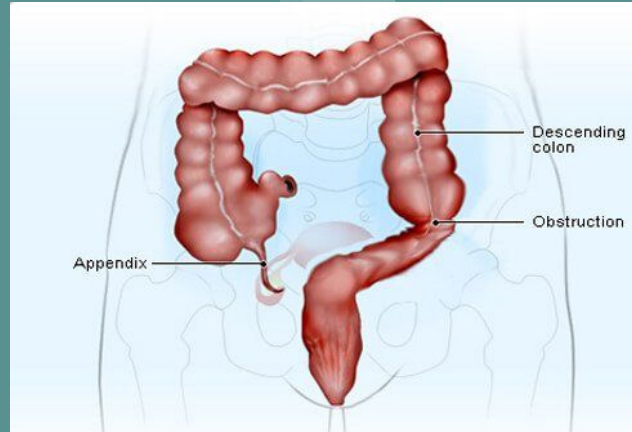

## **Appendix Section ('Appendix' should be centered in top of paper)**

- A section at the end of a paper that includes information that is too detailed for the text of the paper itself and would "burden the reader" or be "distracting," or "inappropriate"
- The content in the appendices should be "easily presented in print format"

# Interview

## What to do for appendix section:


You will transcribe (write out word for word) your entire interview.

## Title the interview:

Last name of interviewee, first name. Personal Interview. Day  
Month Year.

Example: Smith, John. Personal Interview. 13 October 2017.

# Example



**Interviewer:** Good Morning, I'm doing a research project on art in the school curriculum, do you mind If I ask you a few question on your opinions about art

**Teacher:** No not at all. Go ahead.

**Interviewer:** Alright, how would you value art in your classroom on a scale of 1-5?

**Teacher:** I would say a four.

**Interviewer:** Do you mind expanding on why?

**Teacher:** I'm a first grade teacher so while I enjoy art it can be hard to work into assignments sometimes.



# Surveys

What to do for appendix section:

You will need to format the results in a readable way

- Pie chart
- Table
- Bar graph
- Something else?

# Case Studies

What to do for appendix section:

- a) Background of subject- if you are observing one person, give any demographic information: Age, gender identification, etc. Any information about activity you were observing.
- b) Observations- What did you see and observe? There should be no conclusions drawn yet
- c) Interpretations of Observations- based on what you observed, how can you interpret these actions? You may want to give a qualitative score as well like in the example.
